Reading Score

In order to meet the suggested minimum qualification score for reading, an applicant must meet one of the following cutoff scores:

SAT Evidenced Based Reading & Writing 550	ACT Reading 22
GRE Verbal Reasoning 151	PRAXIS CORE Reading 169

Mathematics Score

In order to meet the suggested minimum qualification score for reading, an applicant must meet one of the following cutoff scores:

SAT Mathematics 540	ACT Mathematics 22
GRE Quantitative Reasoning 153	PRAXIS CORE Mathematics 163
