

## STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

Student engagement is a multidimensional construct that drives learning. It is often linked to motivation and active participation. Most theories include three integrated forms:

- Behavioral (actions)
- Emotional (feelings and reactions)
- Cognitive (effort and investment)
