### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Led the turnaround of St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School with an enrollment of 593 to 873. The school in 2014 had failing test scores in reading, language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, vocabulary and spelling as referenced by TerraNova in all grade levels. All grade levels and all subject areas outperformed the diocesan and national benchmarks winning the National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence in 2023. Diversifying the student population was also an area of concern. The Latino population was a mere 2% in 2014. After attending the Latino Enrollment Institute in 2015, Latino enrollment is now at 20% with census data reporting the Latino population in Columbus, Georgia at 4%. The school now boasts a robust ethnic and culturally diverse student population that annually celebrates El Día de los Muertos, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Las Posadas and El Día de los Reyes Magos. These celebrations have caught the attention of local media channels and are often featured on television, social media and print. Enrollment, academics and a lack of diversity were not the only areas of concern, athletics and facilities were in desperate need of repair. Through a \$7M capital campaign, facilities were upgraded to include opening the first diocesan dual language preschool, schoolwide capital improvements and a new sports facility. In 2023, St. Anne-Pacelli won 4 state titles in the areas of cross country, flag football, esports and football.
